At Kitt Peak National Observatory, you can discover your Universe right here on Earth! We offer a unique program that is sure to be the centerpiece of a memorable evening.

Stargaze in our Nightly Observing Program at the site of the world's largest and most diverse research observatory. Admire planets, star clusters, nebulae, and galaxies during your evening on Kitt Peak.

What To Expect:

Your guided evening will include:

- a light meal (deli sandwich) while watching the sunset
- exploring the constellations with the basic tools such as star charts and binoculars
- observing deep-sky wonders with the Visitor Center telescope

Due to the popularity of our program we have expanded to a second dome. However we recommend that reservations be made well in advance of your desired date. Arrival times are provided based on the sunset time for your evening.

This program is weather dependent. In the event of a cloudy night, we will conduct an educational program that will excite your imagination to the wonders of the Universe. In the event the weather clears, we will continue with observing.

- The summit of Kitt Peak is at 6,875 ft. Persons with cardiac, respiratory, or other health related concerns should take proper precautions.
- Mountain environments may vary from windy conditions to extremely cold temperatures, so please dress warmly (hats, gloves etc.). Dress in layered clothing for optimal comfort, feel free to bring a blanket. Mountain temperatures are 15-20 degrees cooler than Tucson. Just a reminder, the domes are not heated.



Directions:

Kitt Peak is 56 miles southwest of Tucson via State Route 86 on the Tohono O'odham Reservation. Allow 90 minutes of drive time from Tucson. Take I-10 to I-19 South. Less than 1 mile is Ajo Way/Hwy 86 (Exit 99). Take this exit West (right). Proceed past Ryan Airfield and Three Points. Continue until Junction 386 (Kitt Peak turnoff). Turn left onto 386. The Kitt Peak Visitor Center is located at the summit (12 miles).
