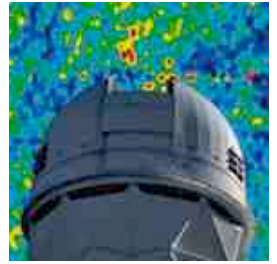

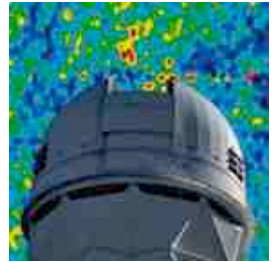
# Break-out Sessions

  - operational modes, reduction/analysis software, meta data, supporting capabilities, precursor capabilities



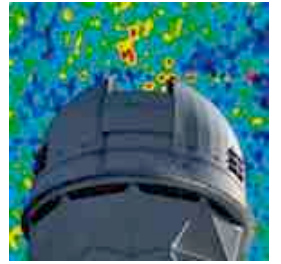
# Break-out Sessions
